FROM THE LEAGUE MANAGER

Postponed Game- Six week Rule (Rules 59-72)A postponed game must be arranged and played within six weeks of the postponed match scheduled date. It is the postponing team's responsibility to offer dates, but if no dates are offered after two weeks, then the opposing team can offer dates, one of these must be accepted to avoid penalties being imposed. Teams are liable for rink fees if not played.

The December Chairman's letter takes on a seasonal flavour with the club's Christmas lunch proving to be increasingly popular. This year's event takes place on Friday 7th December and after the amazing no expense spared pantomime members will tuck into their Christmas lunch before being entertained by a brass band with carols.

You may have noticed the new signs and holders being used in the lobby to promote events being held at the club. These will also be used to assist visitors attending events at the club with directions showing where the Function Room and toilets are located. Another larger notice has been prepared which will be hung around the score board when national competitions are being played on rinks. This is to advise members when these important matches are being held to both encourage support for our players and ensure that great care is taken when walking past the end of the rink to not disturb players about to bowl.

Team members have played many matches recently in national team competitions. We are still in the mens over 60's two rink and the under 25 two rink team competitions. Congratulations to those team players and best wishes for continuing success. Other club individual and team entrants are still playing their early round national matches so do support them when they are playing at the club.

The club competition entry forms are now available for members wishing to enter this years competitions. The closing date is fast approaching so do please complete your entry forms shortly. Competitions are aimed at all levels of playing ability with novice competitions and an unwon competition to enable those with only a limited bowling experience to enjoy a competition against others with limited bowling experience. This year we have introduced a drawn pairs competition combining an experienced bowler playing with a novice. As it is a drawn competition teams novices and experienced bowlers will make separate entries and a draw will combine the entrants into teams. This is an ideal opportunity for experienced bowlers to encourage novices and for novices to enjoy playing alongside an experienced bowler.

We have the second short mat v long mat challenge match coming up on 9th December. Last year we lost this match so do please support the club, particularly those with short mat experience, by putting your name down to play in this event.

Sadly due to lack of people registering their availability the club had to cancel the annual mens v ladies match (not enough men) and the ladies match away at Malvern. It is always sad when the happens, particularly when it involves other clubs, as in due course it will reduce the number of matches available to our players. I know from personal experience that in the early years of bowling some members may feel "they are not yet good enough" to put their names down to play for the club. My advice is to put your name down and then when you play you will be pleasantly surprised how much you enjoy the game and in due course realise how much playing in these matches improves your bowling ability.

As a club we encourage organisations to come to the club for "corporate events". These can vary in length and content from a whole day to a couple of hours. A session of bowling is always included and use of the Function Room for meetings and refreshments are options that can be taken.
