If our volunteers consider that it is not worthwhile continuing due to pressure from their peers, we will be faced with the possibility of reducing the services available, or employing paid staff. This would eventually and inevitably lead to increased prices which nobody wants.

New volunteers are always welcome, especially for evening sessions, reception and maintenance duties.

The Club has been informed that support for the Horizon software will be withdrawn later in 2020, and we have therefore decided to change to the new Bowlr package in time for it to be tested during the 2020 summer season, and introduced fully for the 2020-21 season in September.

Steve Neal, our league manager, will be working very hard to integrate the new system throughout the spring for which the Board is extremely grateful. The new system should allow members to view rink schedules and bookings in more detail than at present, and there are other benefits which could be brought online as familiarity with the system improves.

Finally, concerning the Newsletter, many members admit that they do not always read it and some later complain that they were not aware of events that are taking place. Please discuss the Newsletter with your friends and colleagues to make sure as many members as possible are kept up to date.
