There has been considerable misinformation in respect of the danger of handling cash and notes, so for clarity, please read the following:

The World Health Organisation has never issued any warnings or statements about the use of cash. Instead, it has reiterated that you should wash/sanitise your hands after handling money, especially if you are eating or touching food.



COVID-19 does not spread by penetrating the skin on your hands. Getting corona virus, or other respiratory viruses like influenza, on your hands only leads to infection when it is transferred from your hands to places like your mouth, nose or eyes.



When using contactless or card payments you are still susceptible to potential infection unless you wash/sanitise your hands after touching your phone, card or a payment terminal.



The Board has therefore decided that our policy remains unchanged that card payments should only be used for payments exceeding £15.00. There are sanitisers and wipes available for use by those touching coins, cards or terminals to help eliminate the risk of contamination and infection.
