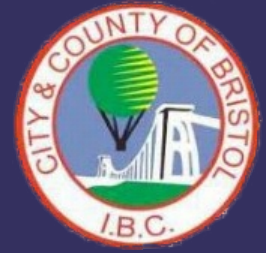

CLUB REOPENING

The Government's COVID RoadMap appears to be on course, which means that the Club can reopen from:

MONDAY 17th MAY 2021

There is a change this year which will see the Club opening every weekday from 10.00am to 2.30pm for the summer months.

Initially, the Club will operate as it did before our enforced closure.

- Masks will be required except when seated at a table for eating and drinking, or when on the rinks.
- Matches will be limited to singles, pairs and triples (Rule of Six).
- Temporary mat positions will be used
- Jacks will be placed, not rolled.
- Mats and jacks will be issued, and need to be returned to cleaning station on completion of a match.

These restriction will be reviewed as we approach 21st June, when they may be eased or abolished in line with advice at the time.

In order to keep the bar and food service available, we are obliged to follow the COVID-19 Regulations which demand table service.

All tables are now numbered, and the procedure is to find a table and wait to be asked for your order.

DO NOT GO TO THE BAR TO ORDER.

When eating and/or drinking, please pay at your table.

DO NOT GO TO THE BAR TO PAY.

When you leave your table, please wipe down the table top and chair arms with an antiseptic wipe.

These arrangements will mean that service is a little slower than previously, and we thank you for your patience.

I CAN'T WAIT !!

CONFUSED? YOU'RE NOT ALONE

Just to clarify the situation about face coverings in the Club.



Face coverings should be worn at all times when moving around the Club and in the changing rooms and toilets.

They may be removed when seated whilst eating/drinking.

They may be removed when on the rinks.

If you are exempt from wearing a face covering, you must maintain social distancing of 2 metres at all times.

To be reviewed as we approach 21st June 2021

IT'S ALL IN THE TIMING

Players should arrive no more than fifteen minutes before their booked playing time whilst COVID restrictions remain in place.

The fifteen minutes at the end of a session are to allow finishing players to leave the rink and for the rink surrounds to be wiped down. There is not always sufficient staff or volunteer numbers to man reception and bar and to clean rinks simultaneously. The following fifteen minutes are to check in the incoming players who may then proceed to the changing rooms without crossing outgoing players.

Early arrivals can lead to backing up at reception and two sets of players in the changing rooms, leading to compromising of social distancing.

More volunteers are needed as the Club is becoming busier. More help in the Club could lead to relaxation of some of the timing issues, but in the meantime.....
