### **BACK TO NORMAL(ish)**

Following the Government's announcement that the remaining Covid-19 restrictions will be lifted from

Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July, the Club will begin returning to normal. However, caution is still the order of the day, and very close contact should be avoided, and the wearing of face masks when moving around the Club will be left for each member to decide. It will no longer necessary to have your temperature and contact details taken when entering the Club, but please do not come to the Club if you experience Covid-like symptoms.

Table service will no longer be compulsory, but please avoid close queuing at the bar. Food and drink should still be consumed while seated at a table.

Spectator seating will be gradually reintroduced into the lounge, and the temporary rink restrictions will be lifted and pre-Covid play will be permitted. However, the Tuesday Open Triples will continue with restricted length play until the fixtures are complete.

The cleaning station and drying rack will remain in place for an interim period for use by staff & volunteers (and members if they so wish).

For the rest of the Summer season, the playing times will remain at 10.00-12.00 & 12.30-2.30 to avoid congestion at reception.

Please bear with us if there is some confusion over arrangements in the first few days. However, entry to the Club will be unrestricted during opening hours.

Not all our members read the Newsletters, so can you please let all your club contacts know about these new arrangements. It would also be extremely useful if you could start thinking about your league team membership for the Winter and establishing who your potential players might be, so that we can get the leagues arranged as soon as possible.

We look forward to welcoming more and more of our members back to the Club as confidence grows, and our outdoor players return to their Winter base. Again, we would ask all our outdoor players to let their colleagues know about us, as new indoor players are not only welcome, but essential for the continuing success of our Club.

When booking a session, the Bowlr system we now use will show the start times as 10.00am and 12.00pm. Please note that the second session will remain at 12.30pm until September 2021.


