## Winter Season 2021 - 2022

The Club will start returning to normal on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> August when five day bowling returns between 10.00am and 4.00pm each weekday. Session times will revert to the normal 10.00am, 12.00pm and

2.00pm. These times will remain in force until the Winter Leagues programme starts on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> September, when the 4.00pm, 6.00pm and 7.00pm sessions will commence.

Membership renewals have started, and reception will be open for membership renewals (and new memberships) each weekday from 10.15am. It would be greatly appreciated if membership renewals could be made avoiding the session changeover periods when reception is extremely busy.

A membership renewal form will accompany this Newsletter, which can be printed and completed, or obtained from the reception desk. Please read the form completely as there is an additional payment option for members who joined or renewed for the 2020-2021 season. Renewing members who opt to pay the full annual fee will help the Club as the difference in cost can be Gift Aided to add 25% to the value.

A few members have enquired about the future of the Club following the Covid pandemic and it is pleasing to report that the financial standing of the Club remains healthy. We began the new financial year in May with £66k in the bank and at 31July this has increased to £69k. Rink utilisation and external functions have been encouraging but significantly we have benefitted from £16k of Covid government support (Back to Work grant, furlough, rates holiday and the lower VAT hospitality rate). Additionally we have taken advantage of the option to defer repaying the Bounce Back loan which otherwise would have begun next month. Importantly, our five year business plan, prepared on a prudent and conservative basis, shows that there is no reason for concern

Expenditure on the building has continued. In addition to the health and safety measures, these include tree reduction works, IT and telephone upgrade, complete electrical installation inspection (including PAT testing), new bowling software, new lockers and day-to-day maintenance. A new Club Manager, Cheryl Brown, was appointed during the pandemic thus ensuring that we are ready for the return to a full programme of bowling.

There has been a recent steady increase in function bookings, with a constant stream of enquiries.

The Club tour in January is almost fully subscribed, and weekend friendly matches are being arranged from October onwards.

The Annual General Meeting has been set for Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021 at 7pm. This is later than in previous years to allow the membership situation to be properly assessed, and to give new members the chance to attend.

The future is bright: the future is burgundy and white!
