

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS AT BIBC

It has been confirmed that the World Singles and Mixed Pairs Championships for 2022 will be held at Bristol Indoor Bowls Club between Monday April 25th and Friday April 29th 2022.

There have previously been two similar 'world' championship tournaments, organised by separate indoor bowling organisations, one based in the Northern hemisphere, and one in the Southern hemisphere. These two organisations have now connected and the 2022 event will be a truly worldwide tournament with more than thirty nations represented.

The format will be round robin matches over four days with the finals being held on Friday. Play will be from 9.30am to around 8.00pm for the first four days, and on Friday morning for the finals. We have invited the Mayor of Bristol to attend a reception for the players and officials on Sunday 24th April.

This is an honour for our club and is due in no small measure to efforts of our previous chairman, Lewis Toman, who was the moving force in bringing these championships to the Club in 2020 (subsequently cancelled owing to the Covid pandemic). Lewis has therefore been invited to take the lead in the organisation of the championships within the Club, and we are happy to report that he has agreed.

There is much to organise between now and then, and the Club is expected to provide hosting, stewarding and marking personnel, and catering for the duration of the matches. New volunteers would be extremely welcome, not only for the event but for the day-to-day operations of the Club. Please speak to Cheryl or a director if you wish to be involved, and keep an eye on the notice boards for updates and specific requests for duties.

Many details remain to be resolved, but it has been agreed that entry to view the World Championships should be free to BIBC members on production of a valid membership card.

Competitors will be arriving for practise sessions during the week preceding the tournament, immediately after Easter, so there will be no opportunity for roll-ups from 19th April.

(Perhaps it should be explained that these championships are not a replacement for the invitational event held at Potters Leisure Resort each year, but are true world championships involving the national champions from around the globe).

WEDNESDAY EVENING OPENING

The Club will be open again on Wednesday evenings from 1st December as an open session. Some members have indicated that they might like to organise an umbrella, or possibly join a new league, and the Club will provide any assistance that they may need to achieve this.

It will be also be an opportunity to play national matches, catch-up league matches, club competition matches, coaching sessions or just roll ups. Such is the level of interest, that it is recommended that you book rinks in advance through Cheryl or reception.

COVID-19 UPDATE from

ENGLISH INDOOR BOWLING ASSOCIATION - 30 November 2021

With the Government issuing new guidance due to the new Omicron variant of COVID-19 from today, we wish to advise you on how these affect the sport of Indoor Bowls.

The wearing of face coverings will be legally required by the public and public facing staff in shops, personal care services and public transport. At this current time this does not apply to Indoor sport / leisure venues but the EIBA would recommend that its affiliated clubs ask their members / visitors to voluntarily wear a face covering when they enter and move around the venue.

The face covering can be removed when they are on the green playing and when having a drink and or meal.

In addition if any of your members / staff live with or have been in contact with someone who has been identified as a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant they must self isolate for 10 days, even if they have been double or triple vaccinated.
