## **SUMMER OPENING TIMES**

## **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING & PRESENTATION EVENING**

As last year, the Annual General Meeting of the Club will be held in October to give new season members a chance to get involved early in their membership.

As the World Bowls Indoor Championships took up a lot of time, it was not possible to confirm a date for the Presentation Evening in May, it was considered that holding it immediately after the AGM would be best way to proceed. This means that the Summer League winners will only have to wait a couple of months for their certificates etc. instead of the usual nine months.

# **NEW CLUB SHIRTS**

With the changing image of bowls, the Club has decided to begin the process of changing the Club's shirt design.

The new shirt will initially be available to members who represent the Club in competitive matches, and will be gradually rolled out over the next few years.

The shirt will be displayed in the shop, and will be paired with black trousers.

The design has been registered with the English Indoor Bowling Association for use in national competitions.

### **RINKSIDE SAFETY**

There have been several issues recently relating to the changeover period on the rinks. Most members are now following the rules of not entering the rinkside until the previous bowlers have vacated, but there are also concerns that several players are still remaining on the rink/rinkside talking instead of vacating the area for the following teams to commence their games.

No one is being asked to rush, safety must come first, but If you have been playing, please do not loiter but safely return to the lounge area as soon as possible after finishing your game.

The bowls gatherers will now be located at the <u>scoreboard end</u> of the rinks (one per rink) and must be safely returned there to the dedicated storage areas at the end of each session.

Bowling bags are **NOT** permitted at rinkside as they present a real trip hazard. Players must change in the locker rooms and carry their bowls to the rink in a bowls carrier or by hand. Bowling bags are not to be stored in the locker room overnight.
